PowerPhotos works with the built-in Photos app on your Mac, providing an array of tools to help you get your photo collection in order.

The app enables you to find and eliminate duplicate photos, split your library into smaller libraries, merge existing libraries together, open libraries in separate windows, export photos/albums, and much more.

Photo management has become an important task since the introduction of digital photography and the ease in which you are able to accumulate and share photos.

iCloud Photo Library

I spend a lot of time interacting with iCloud Photos and for quite some time I was confused as to where my actual files were located. I was not able to locate a clear path.

PowerPhotos, a fast app, with easy to follow instructions, provided me with an answer. It allows me to right click on a file, and then click on “show original file”. It’s simple, and it works perfect.

If you use iCloud Photo Library to sync photos with your other devices, creating multiple libraries can help save on iCloud storage costs. Use a single library to hold a smaller collection that you sync with iCloud, while keeping the bulk of your photos in separate libraries so they don't take up space on iCloud.

Duplicate Filtering

The app allows you to easily search for duplicates, making it fast and simple to get rid of unwanted images.

Library Management

The app allows you to easily organise and edit all of your photos in one convenient place, thus saving time and making it easy to locate and share photos quickly.

Merging Libraries

The app has the ability to merge multiple Photos libraries into one, making it easy to access all of your photos from a single location.
