**CopyClip** is the simplest and most efficient clipboard manager for your Mac. Running discreetly from your menu bar, this app stores all that you have copied or cut in the past, allowing you to quickly find a snippet of text that you have been looking for.

This simple tool will definitely boost your productivity. I find it a very useful utility to have just sitting in the menu bar.

It can record a large number of text-based entries, with the option for you to select how many entries are shown in the interface.

There are some additional customisation options like “blacklisting”, which means that you can configure CopyClip to not record entries from certain apps. The disadvantage is that it can only record text.

Unlike the free version, CopyClip 2 can also record non-text clipboard entries.

If you find that CopyClip offers inadequate control and customisation options, then CopyClip 2 is a better alternative for you.

I do not use CopyClip 2, but it does offer a lot of features for the price you have to pay. Try it and see what you think.
